Software Development

Main reasons for developing ILIAS 3

- Difficulties extending ILIAS 2 due to lack of consistent conceptual framework
- Need for a more flexible access control system for use in complex e-learning scenarios
- Need for modularization
- Compliance to the various e-learning standards
- Easier adaption of design and user interface to CI requirements



Software Development

Changes in ILIAS 3

- New system architecture (layer model)
- Object-Oriented Programming Approach
- Role-based access control system (RBAC) instead of group-based access control system
- XML-based content, SCORM / LOM compatibility
- HTML layout templates



Software Development

Difficulties in developing ILIAS 3

- Usage of advanced technologies and standards which are still under development
- Reliance on new PHP functions which are still in the beta stage (XML/XSLT)
- Need for deploying additional technologies such as Java for functions that can not be implemented with PHP yet
- ILIAS open source development process is still evolving



Software Development

Status quo of ILIAS 3 development –
functions already implemented:

- System core (RBAC, template engine, content data base)
- Personal desktop
- Content presentation
- Mail and forum system
- Cooperation / group system
- Content creation / authoring environment
- System administration



Software Development

To be implemented:

- Redesign of user interface according to usability research
- Course management
- Test/Assessment tool
- Other communication functions such as an integrated chat

Community Building

Strengthening the Developer Community

- Propagation of the developer forum as the most important way of communication within the ILIAS community
- Definition of development guidelines and introduction of Use Cases for a more concise formulation of requirements
- Intense communication with language and help system maintainers



Community Building

Broader user base

- ILIAS becomes more international with strong communities in Italy, Switzerland, France, Austria, South America and East Europe
- ILIAS is used in all kinds of educational institutions - from schools to universities and formative training institutions
